**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF YARD DEBRIS BY THE TOWN OF HAMPTON.**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Hampton, in Council, duly assembled, as follows;

**SECTION I:**

1. The Town has a leaf vac and chipper used to pick up yard debris.
2. The leaf vac handles “sucking up” all the leaves, grass clippings and pine straw.
3. The chipper handles limbs and shrubbery clippings. The Town can only chip limbs that are 3 to 4 feet long and up to 3 inches in diameter and can be handled by 1 person. The Town will not run roots or stumps through the chipper.
4. If debris cannot be run through the chipper and has to be hauled away by the Town, there will be a charge for the use of the backhoe, dump truck and a solid waste fee of \$18.00 per ton.

**SECTION II:**

1. All yard waste, trash, refused or debris resulting from building repairing, remodeling, or any kind of construction shall be removed by the contractor, property owner or person having the work done. The Town shall not remove trash, refused, or debris of this nature.
2. All trees, limbs stumps, bushes, trash, debris, dirt and other refused resulting from cleaning up or improving property shall be removed by the contractor, landscaping contractor, lawn care service, tree surgery company, property owner or person having work done. The Town shall not remove trash, refused or debris of the nature

**SECTION III:**

1. It shall be a violation of the Ordinance to place unauthorized yard debris as herein Described for collection.

**SECTION IV:**

1. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a minimum fine of \$250.00 and Not exceeding \$500.00 or imprisonment not to exceed 30 days.

**SECTION V:**


All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency, are hereby repealed.
